MUDD VOLLEYBALL RULES

Tournament Format:

- 12:00pm – Team Captain Check-in / 12:30pm – Play Begins
- Recreational Format / Underhand serves only
- One day, teams guaranteed 2 matches
- Matches consist of best 2 out of 3 games to 15 pts. using rally scoring. If a match goes to a 3rd game that game will be played until the 20-minute time limit occurs. A coin flip will determine service/side for the 3rd game. The official will announce to both teams when 10 minutes and 5 minutes is remaining in game play.
- If played to full points, the game must be won by 2 pts.
- The top winning team is determined by (in order):
 - a. Winner of most matches
 - b. Winner of head to head matches
 - c. If 2 teams are tied, their head-to-head match determines their order of finish.
 - d. If 3 teams are tied after matches and point differential have been calculated, a coin flip will determine their order of finish.

Teams:

- Each team must have 4 players on the court at all times with a maximum of 6 players on the court at one time
- Teams may consist of all men, all women or co-rec
- All team members must sign waiver/roster
- All players MUST be 18 or older to participate in the adult division
- All player MUST be 9th – 12th grade to participate in the high school division (student id required)

Refereeing:

- All judgment calls are decided by the official. All official decisions are final

Reporting Match Results

- Match results for all games are to be reported to the Tournament Director by the winning team and official of the court
- Results must include scores of both teams and winning teams' manager signature

Service

- Only underhand serves allowed
- Players rotate clockwise on the court and at service
- The server at the beginning of each serve must call out the score.
- Each team is allowed one warning
- Blocking or attacking (hitting) the serve at or above the net results in a side-out

Ball in play:

- All net violations are called
- Open hand hits are permitted, provided the ball is not caught, thrown, held, grasped, or otherwise directed
- Court boundary lines is the dirt outlining the mud court. The ball must land inside the mud court in order for it to be ruled a legal (“in”) ball. Basically the ball needs to touch some mud in the court in order for it to be ruled “in”.
- Limit of no more than 3 legal hits before the ball crosses the net into the opponent’s playing area or is touched by the opponent. When the team’s first contact is simultaneous contact by opponents, or an action to block, the next contact is considered the team’s first hit.

Weather Policy:

- The tournament can be cancelled due to dangerous or unsafe weather conditions
- Games may be suspended during inclement weather. All TRC weather policies apply

Other Tournament Policies:

- Shoes are optional
- No alcoholic beverages can be brought onto the grounds
- No pets allowed!
- No tobacco products allowed on premises
- Clean up before you leave!
- No Refunds!
