## **OPERATING INFORMATION & RULES FOR VENDOR PARTICIPANTS**

## Saturday, October 12<sup>th</sup>, 2024

Are you interested in being a vendor at the 39th Turner Days Festival? Turner Days is a nonprofit event held annually, hosted by the Turner Days Committee. We are a group of volunteer community members that work in conjunction with the Turner USD 202. This year's festival is Saturday, October 12th, 2024, located on the Turner Days Field at 5800 Metropolitan Ave, Kansas City, KS 66106. Activities, vendors, or other organized groups from the most recent year the event was held, shall be given priority over others, and be granted the same space as was held in that prior year if application is turned in by September 15<sup>th</sup>. 2024. After this date, booth spaces will be available on a first come, first serve basis. Turner Days is a oneday event only. In the event of a rain out, the event will be moved to Sunday, October 13th.

Early booth set-up will be available Friday, October 11th from Noon-8:00pm. Saturday set-up begins at 6:00am. All vendor vehicles must begin exiting off the field no later than 8:45am. After 9:00 am absolutely NO vehicles are allowed in or out of the field. The Turner Days Committee staff will be equipped with gators and golf carts to help you shuttle supplies & staff if needed.

The festival opens to spectators at 10:00am. Vendors must stay until the festival closes at 6:00pm.

## **FESTIVAL RULES -**

- 1. NO weapons, firearms, explosives, or controlled substances of any kind (drugs, alcohol, or replicas of) shall be sold, used, consumed, or carried on the premises of the event.
- 2. NO bicycles, unauthorized vehicles, skateboards, scooters, or such similar items are permitted on the premises during the event.
- 3. Individual or group behaviors that are disruptive, dangerous, or obnoxious are cause to be requested to vacate the premises. If refused, the individual or group will be escorted off the premises by security.
- 4. Committee chairs shall take action to ensure the safety of individuals and activities within their assigned responsibilities including the right to exclude individuals, groups, or activities which in their judgment, pose a threat to safety.
- 5. DO NOT sell or ask to sell/display any merchandise of any kind, and in any form, that may promote alcohol, drugs, or violence. All alcohol, sexual innuendo, profanity, racist, derogatory, or gang affiliated items are STRICTLY PROHIBITED.

The Turner Days Committee reserves the right to prohibit the sale of any item the committee may deem undesirable. If you are unsure if an item may be considered offensive, please call the vendor official, Tammy Wake at (913)991-3736, before the day of the event to check.

Please remember, this is a community - family-oriented event, held on Turner USD 202 property. Actions taken & activities held should reflect a healthy and safe atmosphere. Vendors in violation of this policy will be removed immediately with no refunds. As always, the Turner Days Committee appreciates you and your continued support of the Turner Days Festival.
